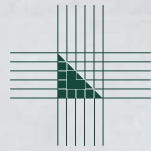

THE GOLDEN BROCADE OF NISHIJIN

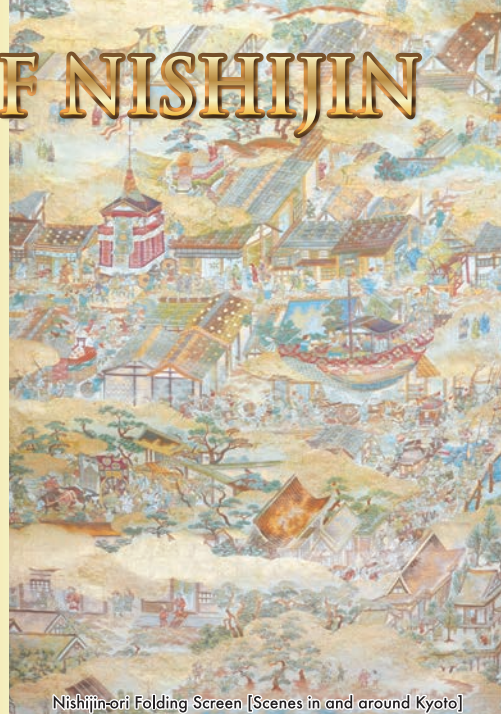
Rinpa is an artistic school that developed during the Edo period, characterized by its brilliant use of gold and silver, bold compositions, and designs that make effective use of empty space. Over time, Japanese crafts were introduced to Europe and influenced Impressionist artists through the movement known as Japonism.

Inspired by these aesthetics, Nishijin weaving recreates the expression of paintings and light through weaving, using gold threads and a rich variety of colored threads. The result is a unique combination of delicacy and brilliance.

We invite you to explore the world of Nishijin weaving, where traditional craftsmanship meets modern sensibility, and experience the deep harmony between Japanese and Western beauty.

UCHIKAKE & KIMONO PHOTO EXPERIENCE

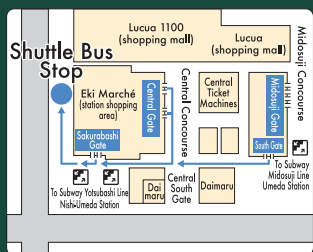

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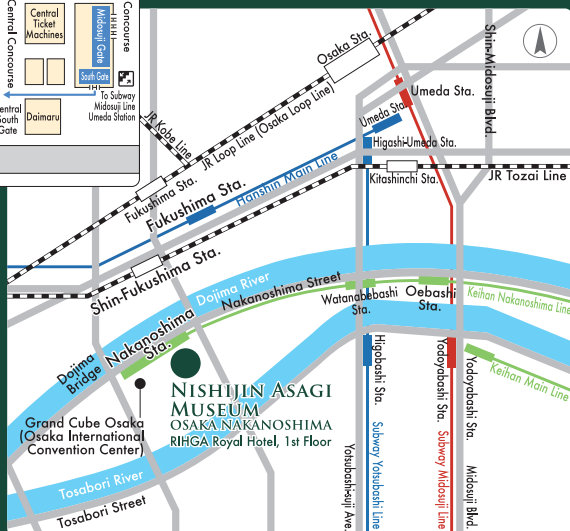
